

Feedback on Retirement Provision Certificate Performance | 15 July 2026 Exam Sitting

Introduction:

This report provides feedback on the **Retirement Provision Certificate** examination held on **15 July 2026**.

This 120 minute exam consists of 80 multiple choice questions drawn from the learning material available on the PMI website.

Exam Overview:

The exam was delivered online via TestReach, with **22** candidates participating. Candidates receive a Pass or Fail result, accompanied by their raw score and percentage. The examiners' decision is final, and no additional details regarding individual exam papers are provided.

Overall Performance:

The pass rate for this sitting was 41%, with 9 candidates successfully completing the exam. The highest score was 74/80 marks, and no candidate scored below 28 marks.

Key Areas for Improvement:

The areas below are the topics where the five questions with the lowest scores came from:

1. Workplace\Contracting out of State Pension Schemes
2. Workplace\Benefits paid from Workplace Pension Schemes
3. Pensions Industry\Origins and Overview
4. Workplace\Administration and Governance of Workplace Pension Schemes
5. Investment\Bonds
