

# Feedback on Retirement Provision Certificate Performance | 18 March 2026 Exam Sitting

## **Introduction:**

This report provides feedback on the **Retirement Provision Certificate** examination held on **18 March 2026**.

This 120 minute exam consists of 80 multiple choice questions drawn from the learning material available on the PMI website.

## **Exam Overview:**

The exam was delivered online via TestReach, with **20** candidates participating. Candidates receive a Pass or Fail result, accompanied by their raw score and percentage. The examiners' decision is final, and no additional details regarding individual exam papers are provided.

## **Overall Performance:**

The pass rate for this sitting was 45%, with 9 candidates successfully completing the exam. The highest score was 75/80 marks, and no candidate scored below 42 marks.

## **Key Areas for Improvement:**

The areas below are the topics where the five questions with the lowest scores came from:

1. Trusteeship\Trusteeship Responsibilities
2. Individual Provision\Stakeholder
3. Role of Government\Statutory Bodies
4. Workplace\Administration and Governance of Workplace Pension Schemes
5. Investment\Property
