## CERTIFICATE IN DC GOVERNANCE

### Examiners' Report - September 2019 Public Examination

#### Introduction

The examination of the Certificate in DC Governance consists of a one and ½ hour paper containing 60 multiple choice questions. These questions are drawn from a wide-ranging syllabus, published on the PMI website. A selection of sample questions can be found on the Institute's website [www.pensions-pmi.org.uk](http://www.pensions-pmi.org.uk).

This examination was taken by a total of 24 candidates.

For the examination you will either achieve a Pass or Fail, which is stated on your result notification. The decision of the examiners is final, and no further breakdown of the results is available.

The overall pass rate for the examination was 91.6% - equating to 22 candidates out of 24 passing the examination. The highest score was 54 and the lowest score was 44 (out of 60).

#### Examiners' Feedback on performance

The purpose of this report is to summarise performances across the syllabus.

In doing so it will indicate those syllabus areas that were answered not so well by most candidates.

There were no specific areas of the syllabus where questions were answered less well. It is recommended, indeed it is vitally important, that all candidates look at the syllabus, as this lists all

the areas that could be included in an examination, PLUS fully prepare for the examination by thoroughly working through the study manual.
