

## Examination re sittings and deferrals

### **Exam deferrals**

If a learner would like to defer an exam entry, they can only defer 2 exam sittings within a year.

**For example**, if you sat an exam in March 2019, you can defer to Autumn 2019 and then again to March 2020, however you are not permitted to defer beyond this limit.

### **Exam re-sits**

If a learner would like to apply for a re-sit of an exam, you can only pay the resit price, if you have taken the same exam within a year.

**For example**, if you originally took CU1A in April 2019 and wished to re-sit CU1A in April 2020, this would be permitted as a re-sit.

If you originally took CU1A in April 2019 and wished to re-sit CU1A in Autumn 2020, you would be required to pay for a full exam sitting.

**Please note:** If you wish to defer or re-sit an exam, you may only do so if your Membership is kept up to date.
