

Feedback on Award in Pension Trusteeship Performance | 15 July 2026 Exam Sitting

Introduction:

This report provides feedback on the **Award in Pension Trusteeship** examination held on **15 July 2026**.

This 90 minute exam consists of 60 multiple choice questions drawn from the learning material available on PMI website.

Exam Overview:

The exam was delivered online via TestReach, with **32** candidates participating. Candidates receive a Pass or Fail result, accompanied by their raw score and percentage. The examiners' decision is final, and no additional details regarding individual exam papers are provided.

Overall Performance:

The pass rate for this sitting was 91%, with 29 candidates successfully completing the exam. The highest score was 55/60 marks, and no candidate scored below 40 marks.

Key Areas for Improvement:

Based on an analysis of questions with the lowest scores, we recommend focusing revision on:
